Think About Money As Finances.

- ▶ Implement financial safeguards.

- ▶ Protect yourself and the integrity of those who work for you.

Have your CPA audit your accounts at least once a year.

- ▶ Be careful of those who spend your money freely.

They care the least about how you earn it and where it comes from. These individuals are most likely to abuse and misappropriate funds. Discern their motives and intentions.

Judas managed Jesus' finances but violated his trust. He resented the generosity of Jesus. He was a thief.

“Then saith one of His disciples, Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, which should betray Him, Why was not this ointment sold for three hundred pence, and given to the poor? This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein,” (John 12:4-6).

The love of money motivated Judas to betray Jesus. He committed suicide because he loved money more than he loved Jesus.

The people who handle your finances should exemplify the same qualities as The Proverbs 31 Woman. (See Proverbs 31:10-31.) Her industry, selflessness and conscientiousness set her above all the rest. She was completely reliable, dependable and trustworthy. You cannot be too careful when it comes to finances.

- ▶ Hire the best people and strive to keep them at their best.

When you negotiate, you open up an opportunity to save.


2 Principles You Should Remember When You Negotiate With Others.

Your Attitude Can Determine Your Success.

Most people with wrong attitudes do not even realize they possess them. They use angry words, sarcasm or cynicism to manipulate those around them. They use their attitude to rule and reign over those under their authority. This is contrary to The Word.

“But Jesus called them to Him, and saith unto them, Ye know that they which are accounted to rule over the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and their great ones exercise authority upon them. But so shall it not be among you: but whosoever will be great among you, shall be your minister: And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all,” (Mark 10:42-44).

NEVER NEGOTIATE WITH A GIVER



Never Question The Value of A Gift.

People say, “It’s not the gift, but the thought that counts.” This is true. The greatest gifts in the world will come from a person’s heart, not from their pocketbook.

Remember the story of the widow’s mite? Jesus valued her gift the most because it came from her heart, not from her abundance. She gave out of her want and need. The rich gave out of their abundance. Their gift meant nothing.

When you are given a gift, it would be very rude and inconsiderate to ask how much it is worth. The gracious person will always accept a gift in the spirit in which it is given.

Abraham learned that you could not put a value on a gift. He tried to bargain with God about sparing Sodom and Gomorrah. He wanted more for less. He wanted a bigger gift. Will you spare the city if there are 50 righteous persons? Forty-five? Forty? Thirty? Twenty? Ten? It did not work.

God’s gift was for Lot and his family to escape. It was not for a wicked and depraved population to go unpunished.

Always accept a gift for what it is.

Never deny someone the opportunity to receive a

blessing by refusing to receive his or her gift.

Are you saying that the value of the gift is too little?

Too much? The value is immaterial. It is the motive behind the gift. Honor those who give. Be gracious and sincere.

Jesus taught, “It is more blessed to give than to receive,” (Acts 20:35). Givers understand this.

- ▶ Givers understand the rewards of giving.
- ▶ Givers understand the law of sowing for a Harvest.
- ▶ Givers understand the benefits and blessings of tithing.
- ▶ Givers know God loves a cheerful giver.
- ▶ Givers know it is more blessed to give than to receive.
- ▶ Givers see themselves as financial deliverers.

They sow with great expectation. They know ***An Uncommon Seed Will Always Create An Uncommon Harvest.***

- ▶ A true giver gives from a pure heart.
- ▶ A true giver gives with a pure motive.
- ▶ A true giver gives as an expression of gratitude and appreciation.

Everyone has a need to give. Everyone has something to give. Giving is a God characteristic. This is why God treasures the giver.

Poverty is a thief. It steals much more than your finances. It steals your dream. It steals your sense of worth. It steals your significance. It steals your ability to bless those around you.

God is a giver. He wants to bless you financially. “Let the Lord be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of His servant,” (Psalm 35:27).

WHEN THEY SAY IT IS GOING TO COST MORE, ASK WHY



Sometimes More Means Less.

When something costs more, doesn't it stand to reason that you should get more for your money? A first-class seat on a commercial flight cost hundreds more than a coach seat.

The reason you get so much more for your money is:

- ▶ You sit in a plush over-sized seat with plenty of leg and elbow room.
- ▶ First-class passengers usually have their own bathroom and they always receive first-class service, first.
- ▶ In first-class there is a dedicated flight attendant who waits on you exclusively.
- ▶ You are the first to board and deboard the plane.
- ▶ There is a special passenger's lounge for you to relax in before your flight and between layovers.
- ▶ You have greater amenities and privileges than the coach passengers because you paid more to travel first-class.

When a salesperson says an item or service is going to cost more, always ask them how much more is and what the extra benefits are that come with paying more.

In some instances, when the price goes up, the quality

and service goes down. Make sure you know what you are getting for your money, especially if it is going to cost you more.

We pay more for gasoline than ever before and there is no service to go with it. We pay more and pump it ourselves.

It used to be that when you pulled up to the pump, a gas station attendant would wash your windows, check under the hood, top off your fluids, check the air pressure in your tires and sweep out your floorboard. That is when they called a gas station a service station.

Now we call them convenience stores and we enjoy the convenience of getting out and pumping our gas ourselves. Sometimes you do not get what you pay for, or you get very little value for it.

The price should be what you pay for value.

Always get the most value for your money. You would expect this when you purchase an automobile or a home. You should expect the same thing on every purchase you make no matter how small. Be a wise shopper. Be a smart consumer.

You've heard the old saying, "You get what you pay for." Make sure you do get what you pay for, especially if it cost you more.

When They Say It Is Going To Cost More, Ask What More Is.

Protect Your Schedule.

What is your time worth to you? Minimum wage? Ten dollars an hour? Fifteen dollars an hour? Twenty-five dollars an hour? One hundred dollars an hour? Time is money. How much money do you waste in time?

- ▶ You cannot store time.
- ▶ You cannot collect it.
- ▶ You cannot place it in a special vault and save it for a rainy day.

Look at your watch. Time clicks by every second. You are only permitted to spend your time, wisely or foolishly. You must do something with time. Wise men discern the value of time. “A wise man’s heart discerneth both time and judgment,” (Ecclesiastes 8:5).

- ▶ You will either waste time or win time.
- ▶ You will either invest it wisely or you will squander it foolishly.
- ▶ You control your time. How you spend it and just as importantly, how others spend it for you.

Everyone has an agenda. Be careful of those who use

their agenda to distract you and pull you “off course.” Do not let others make their agenda your agenda.

Protect your priorities. Jesus did. There is a fascinating story in the Bible about it.

Lazarus, a close friend of Jesus, became sick. Mary and Martha, his two sisters, sent word to Jesus to come quickly. Jesus did not hurry. He kept His own agenda. He had His own list of priorities and He would not let even some of His dearest friends compromise His schedule.

You must learn to discern other people’s sense of urgency. Everything is not an emergency.

When Jesus heard of His friend’s illness, He did not ignore the situation, He simply followed through with His own schedule first. He prioritized. He would give attention to Mary and Martha’s urgency, but on His own terms and His own time.

The Bible says, “When He had heard therefore that he was sick, He abode two days still in the same place where He was,” (John 11:6).

When you seek to protect your own agenda, expect others to question your judgment and try to put you on a guilt trip. Martha seemed especially miffed at Jesus. “Lord, if Thou hadst been here, my brother had not died,” (John 11:21).

Make your time count. Discern when others are distracting you from your schedule.

Some people just want your time and attention. There is a sense of power when another person can push a button and manipulate your actions. It is all about control, not concern.

If time is money, other people will value and respect your time, agenda and schedule.
